I was born in Detroit, Michigan on March 23, 1988 and am the eldest of two sisters. My parents are both nurses and are amazing people!

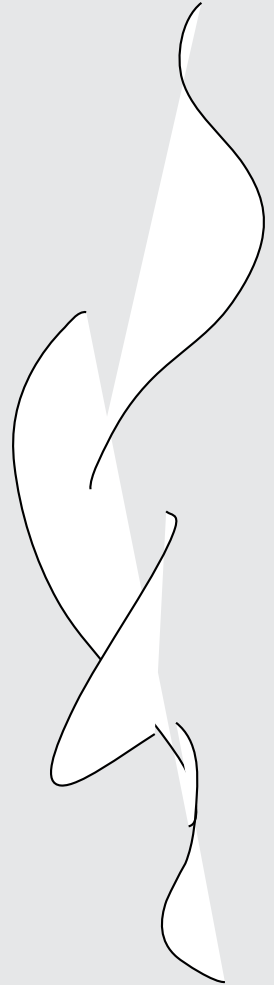
My family and I moved to Houston, TX in 1989, and then to Sugar Land, TX in 1990 and have lived there ever since.

I decided to transfer to the University of Houston in the Fall of 2008 to pursue a double major in Graphic Communications and Psychology.



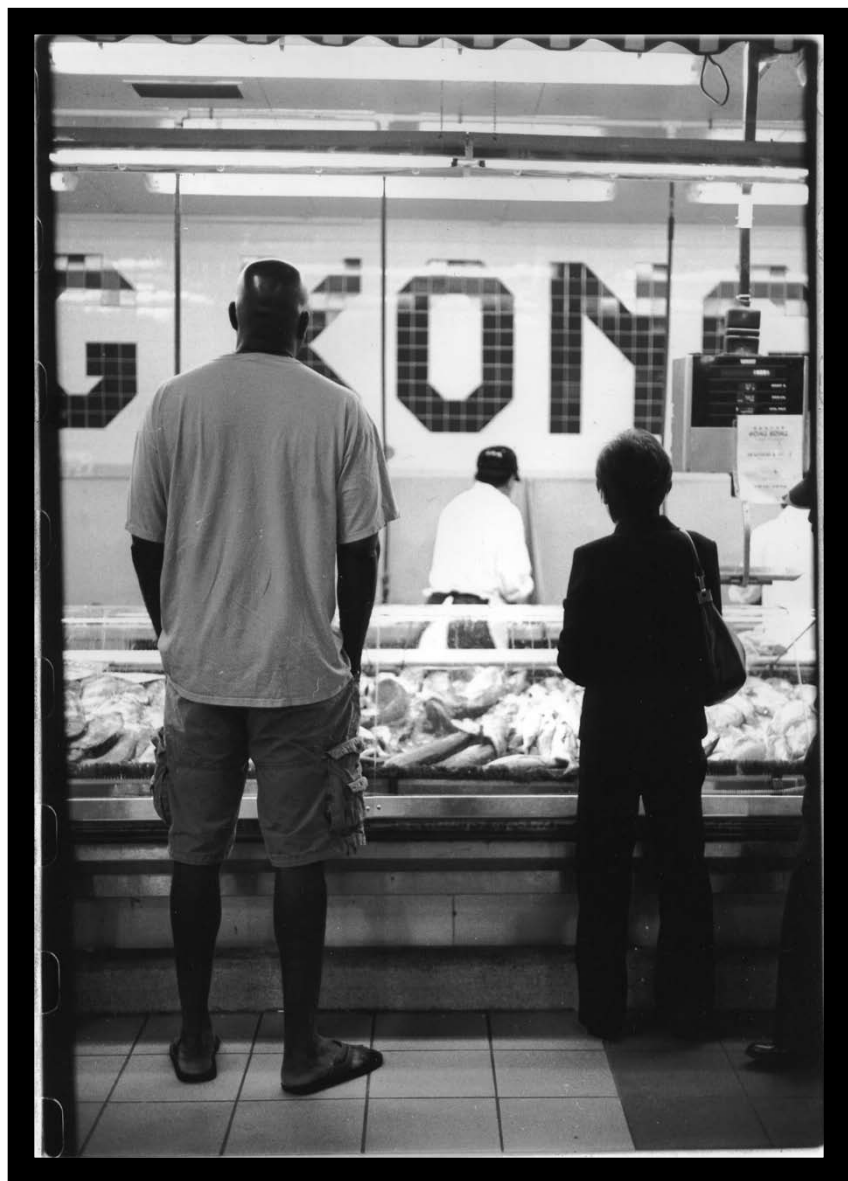
Photography

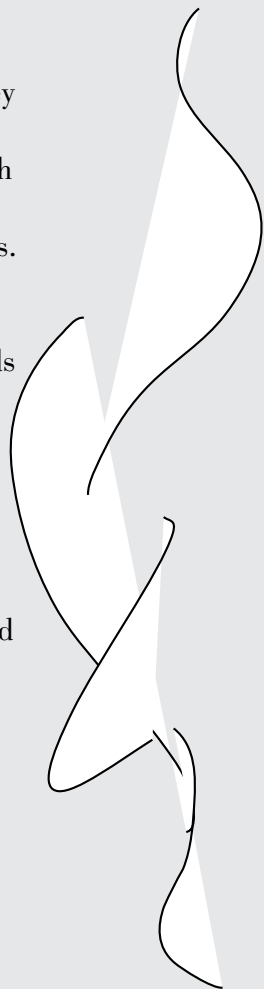
Longboarding
